Built for George Walton in 1795, College Hill is a two-story wood house with weatherboarded and clapboarded walls, gable roof, and a brick chimney at either end. A fine two-story wood veranda, consisting of a series of segmental arches supported on delicate square columns on pedestals, extends across the full width of the seven-bay wide front (north) elevation. The main house is about 52-feet wide and 30-feet deep and has a one-story 15 by 16-foot kitchen, added in 1898, attached to the southwest (rear) corner.

The wide center double doors in the first and second stories of the facade are framed by pilasters and have segmental fanlights over sidelights. Windows on both stories are adorned by exterior louvered shutters.

In plan a central hall, divided into two sections, extends through the house and separates the four rooms on the first floor into pairs. The two major (front) rooms have fireplaces and the smaller (rear) rooms have none. A graceful curved U-shaped stair is located in the right-hand rear corner of the large front hall, and behind this hall is a smaller rear hall. The hall walls are plastered and the principal rooms have board walls covered with paper and wainscotting. The mantels in these larger rooms are enriched with Adam style pilasters and sunbursts in their entablature.

The center hall plan is repeated on the second floor, where there are five bedrooms. The house has been little-altered and has never been restored. Used as a private residence, College Hill is not open to visitors. The original kitchen was located in a separate building that is no longer standing.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Evonts, Etc.)

College Hill, also known as the Harper House, was the residence from 1795 to 1804 of George Walton, a signer of the Declaration of Independence for Georgia, lawyer, politician, soldier, governor and chief justice of Georgia, and a U.S. Senator.

## HISTORY

On January 10, 1787 the State of Georgia granted Walton the 100 acres of land that originally made up this farm, then located on the outskirts of Augusta. College Hill was built by George Walton in 1795 and on July 4 of that year he wrote to a friend. "Having completed a mansion of my own at this place and removed my family, you will please take possession of Meadow Garden place (the cottage in which the Waltons' had been residing prior to 1795) as trustee of my sons," thus indicating that Walton had moved to the newly completed "College Hill." During this last period of Walton's life he was a judge of the superior court of Georgia from 1793 to 1795 and from 1799 to 1804. In 1795-96 he was appointed to fill out the unexpired term of a Georgia Senator in the U.S. Senate. Walton died at College Hill on February 2, 1804 and was buried in the Rosney Cemetery at Augusta. In 1848, however, his remains were removed and reinterred at the monument erected in Augusta to Georgia signers of the Declaration of Independence.

College Hill has been owned by the Harper family, descendants of George Walton, since 1885.

## College Hill, 2216 Wrightsboro Road, Augusta, Georgia

George Walton, a Signer of the Declaration of Independence for Georgia, was a lawyer, politician, soldier, governor, chief justice, and U.S. Senator. Born near Farmyille, Virginia, and left an orphan at an early age, Walton was raised by an uncle and apprenticed to be a carpenter. In 1769, at the age of 20, he moved to Savannah, Georgia, where he studied law and was admitted to the bar in 1774. With the exception of 1778 and 1779, Walton served continuously in the Continental Congress from 1776 until September 27, 1781. In 1778 he was commissioned a colonel in the Georgia militia, served during the siege of Savannah, and was there wounded and captured by the British in December 1778. He was exchanged in September 1779. The revolutionary government of Georgia was torn by dissension in 1779 and the most influential faction elected Walton governor; he held this office from November 1779 to January 1780. After the War he served from 1783 to 1789 as chief justice of Georgia, his second term as governor from 1789 to 1790, and as a U.S. Senator for Georgia, from 1795 to 1796.

About 1790 Walton took up residence in Augusta and in 1795 built College Hill which served as his home from 1795 until his death in 1804. The little-altered house has never been restored. College Hill is a private residence, and is not open to visitors.
