- First planned group building in U.S.
- Famous "Newspaper Stagecoach Inn"
- Built 1844 by Milton's founder Joseph Govekitch
- 24 rooms Stagecoach Pioneer Exhibit
- 1837 Govekitch Log Cabin
- Located in the Underground Railroad
- Restored & operated by Milton Historical Society
- Listed on the National Register of Historic Places
