



NEW MEMORIAL DEDICATED TO FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT

WARM SPRINGS, Georgia -- This new Franklin D. Roosevelt Memorial Museum is filled with irreplaceable historic and personal mementos associated with the life of the late President.

The former home of Miss Georgia Wilkins, close friend and neighbor of Mr. Roosevelt, it was willed to the Warm Springs Memorial Commission as part of the shrine maintained in the President's memory. 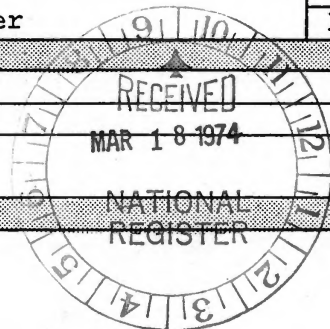

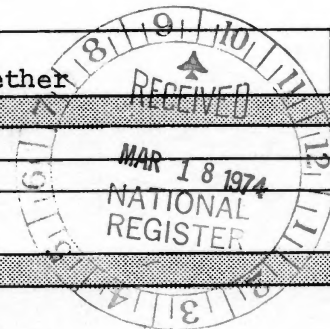

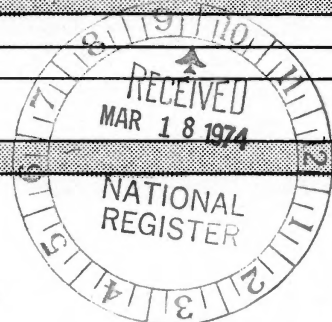
