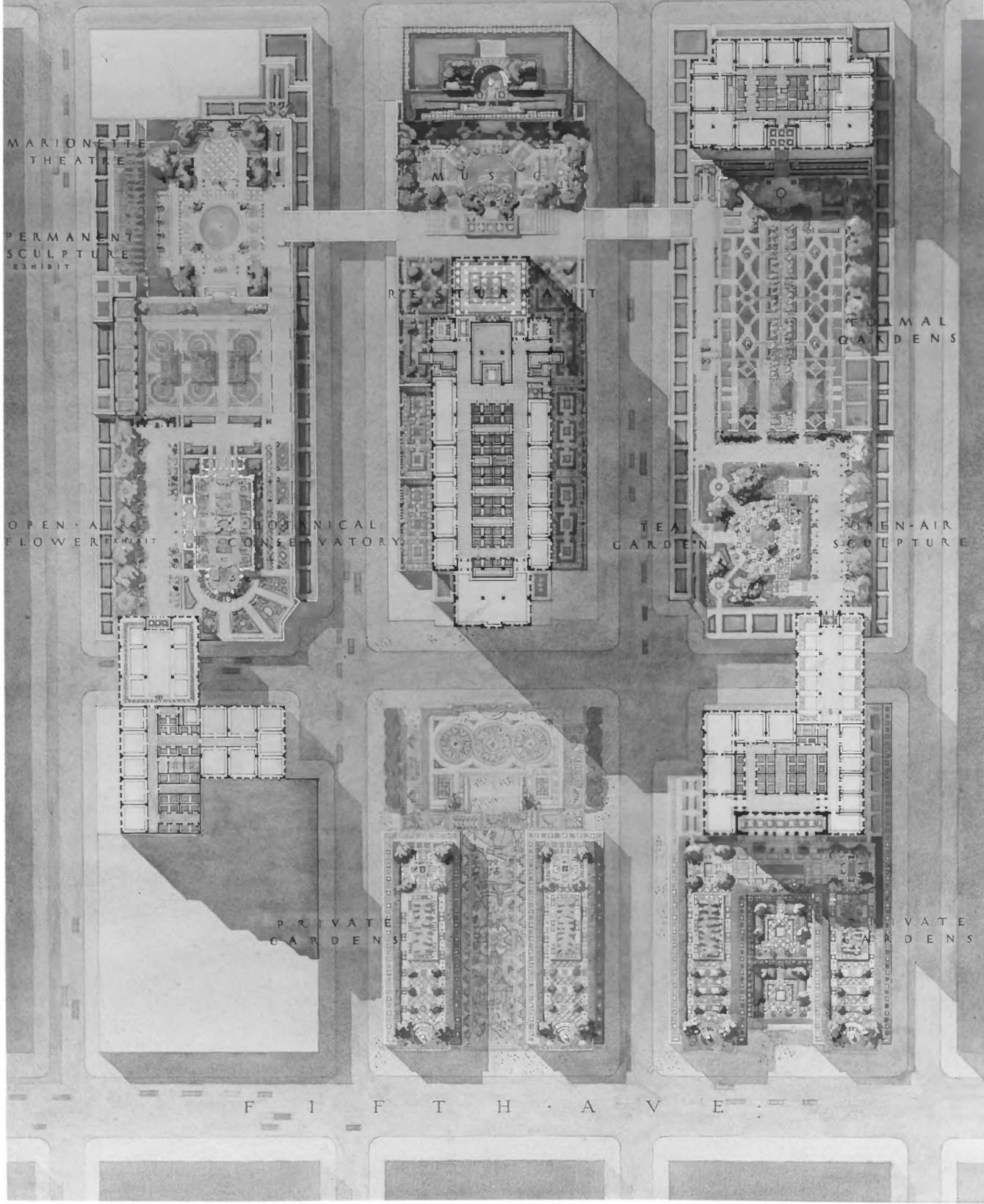

RADIO CITY MUSIC HALL ENTERTAINMENT CENTER'S
AUDITORIUM

The most striking feature of the theatre auditorium is an immense proscenium arch, sixty feet in height.
