



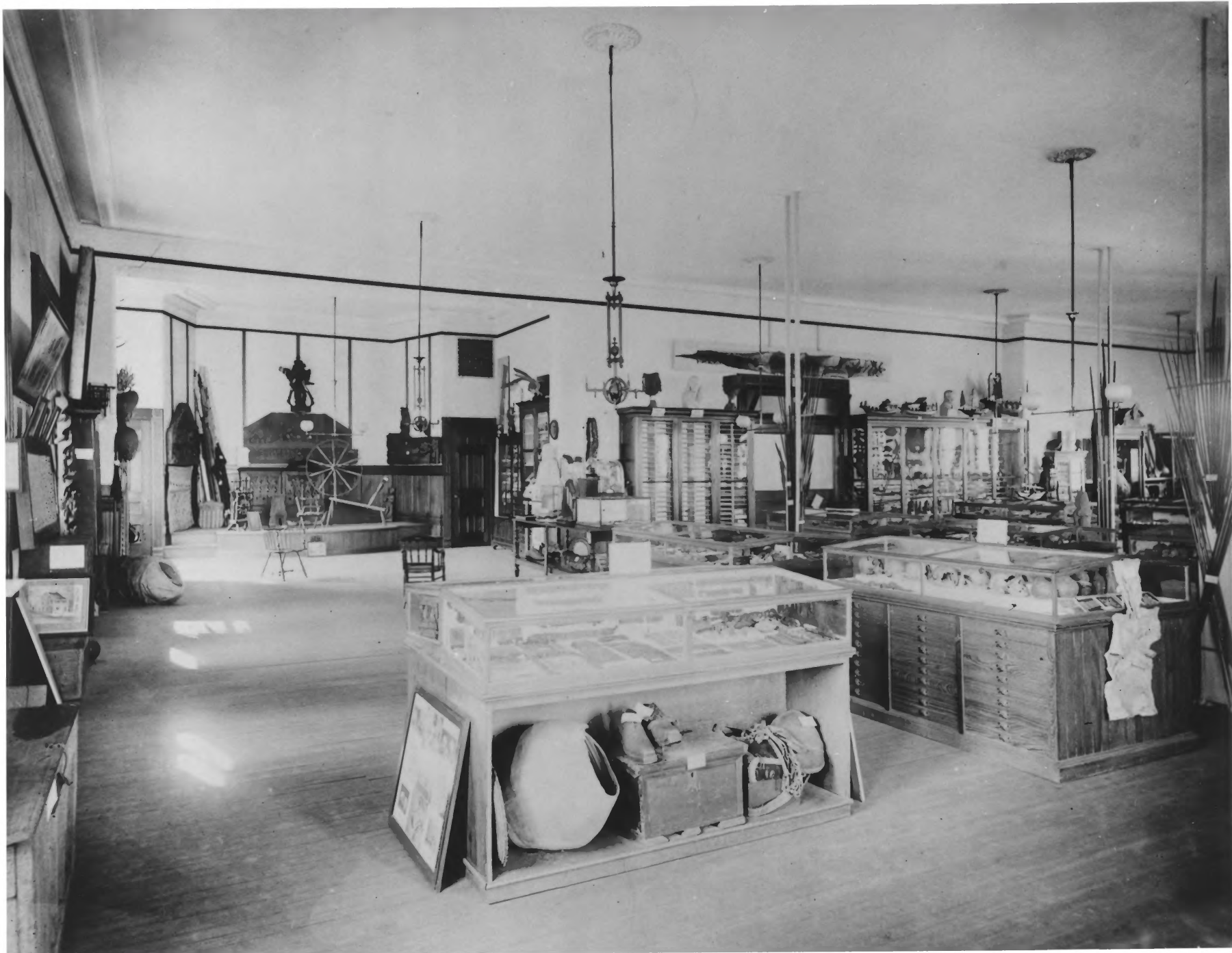






HISTORIA TESTIS TEMPORUM

BROOKLYN BRIDGE

The Brooklyn Bridge was the first steel-cable suspension bridge in the world. It was designed by John Augustus Roebling and built by his son, Washington Augustus Roebling, with the help of his son-in-law, John Augustus Roebling, Jr. The bridge was the first to use steel cables and was the longest suspension bridge in the world at the time of its opening in 1883.
