


Figure 7.23: Bricks: (upper) yellow; (lower) red, Fort Orange Archeological Site, Albany, New York (Photograph by Paul R. Huey).




Figure 7.24: Delft plate, Fort Orange Archeological Site, Albany, New York (Photograph by Paul R. Huey).




Figure 7.26: Red earthenware, Fort Orange Archeological Site, Albany, New York (Photograph by Paul R. Huey).




Figure 7.28: Round glass beads, Fort Orange Archeological Site, Albany, New York (Photograph by Paul R. Huey).




Figure 7.29: Tubular glass beads, Fort Orange Archeological Site, Albany, New York (Photograph by Paul R. Huey).
