The first school in Washington Valley, also at the corner of Washington Valley Road and Schoolhouse Lane, was built in 1813. Built by local people, the school was open to nearly every youngster. Tuition was paid in either currency, firewwod, or repair work to the schoolhouse.

Fifty years later this small school was inadequate and, in 1868, a committee was "appointed to examine school with reference to building a new one". This red brick school, built in 1869 at a cost of \$2,025, was constructed on the site of the old schoolhouse.

Records of the school indicate that teachers at the time were miserably paid and were also often employed to do custodial work in the school.

The school term lasted nine months. Few youngsters, however, attended classes the entire time. For example, in the year 1877, out of a total enrollment in the school of 39, merely 4 students were in class for the nine month period and only 14 more attnded for at least 6 months. The daily attendence averaged around twenty. This was in fact quite fortunate for the instructor since the school would comfortably seat only thirty pupils.

One room schoolhouses were on the decline in Morris County by early 20th century. The May, 1913 school minutes of the valley schoolhouse read: "Resolved that Washington Valley School children be transported to the Hillside School ..."

Local citizens protested vehemently, but to no svail. When the Little Red School closed that fateful summer the doors were to never sgain open as a schoolhouse.
