After 1761, New Mexico missions began constructing wooden altar screens. The maker of the Laguna altar screen is unknown by name, but his powerful style and use of twisted Sodomic pillars are the finest in New Mexico. He carved the altar screen at San Miguel Chapel, Santa Fe (1798), Zia (1798), and Santa Ana and Acoma.

An inventory of 1840 describes the Church and altar screen as fine, well carved and painted with spiral columns, three shells, the trinity above, the painting of the patron on buffalo hide and Garcia's crucifix, as well as the buffalo hide canopy over the altar, very neat and all as they are today.
