Boise's old Carnegie Public Library is a handsome brick structure in the French Renais ance style. A short flight of steps leads up to the projecting central bay which contains the double front doors. A pattern of graceful round arches marks the facade, contrasting with the rectilinear lines of the building. On either side of the central bay is a trio of tall, round-arched windows, and the central bay itself contains a large, round-arched window above the entrance and a smaller one on either side. Emphasizing these round-arched windows are rusticated stone arches, with keystones in all but the arch above the main door. All other windows are rectangular, with lintels of brick set at an angle. A pedimented gable tops the central bay, and a low hip roof tops the main structure. The simple projecting cornice is complete with dentils, a pattern which is continued in the pedimented gable.

The building was constructed of materials local in Boise. The beige pressed birck was mde in Boise, and the sandstone used in the foundation and trim was quarried from Table Rock just east of town.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

As the city of Boise grew in size, the need for a larger and more permanent library became apparent. In 1902, a request was made to Mr. Andrew Carnegie by the secretary of the state library commission, bearing the endorsement of Gov. F. W. Hunt. Carnegie gave the city \$20,000 for a new building, but as this was not quite sufficient, the city donated \$4000 more and the Columbian Club an additional, \$1000. The school board donated the site at the corner of Eigth and Washington, only a block from the State capitol.

The board of trustees of the library solicited plans from architects all across the country. By the deadline of Feb. 1,1904, 17 sets of plans had been submitted including four local Boise firms. After much deliberation, J. E. Tourtellotte of Boise was awarded first prize in the contest, giving him supervision of construction as well as 5% of the cost. The second prize went to C. Z. Hubbell of Spokane and third prize went to Campbell and Wayland of Boise.

The trustees wanted the new library to be local from the foundation up. The brick was locally made, the sandstone locally quarried, and the design was from a Boise architect. Labor, of course, was supplied locally, with the contract awarded in July 1904 to Michels and Weber of Boise.

The work proceeded more slowly than expected. The building was originally scheduled to be opened by the middle of February 1905, but did not open until May. Great excitement surrounded the opening of the new library. A grand ball was held on May 1st, with the new building open for tours that evening. The dedication was to follow the next day but had to be postponed until May 3 because of inclement weather. Judge C. C. Goodwin from Salt Lake was the main speaker, with others sharing the platform with him. All, of course, were lavish in their praise of the new library and its effect on the growing city.

After almost 70 years in the same building, the library finally moved to new quarters in 1973. The old building is still in use, however, after being converted quite successfully to office space. This is the best of the few surviving examples of Carnegie libraries in Idaho.
