The Burns Union School Building is a two-story Renaissance style structure with a full basement and an attic. The Renaissance traits in the building are subdued but evident. The building is L-shaped with the main entrance in an appendage at the inside corner of the "L." The building rests on a foundation of rough-cut limestone which extends about six feet above ground level and ends at the sill line of the first floor windows. The stone is coursed in horizontal layers and gives a massive base to the building. The walls above the foundation are constructed of red face brick laid in running bond. The wood shingled roof is gabled on one side of the "L" and hipped on the other. A broad wooden cornice which is devoid of any ornamentation separates the roof from the wall below.

Windows on the first and second floors are grouped in two's and three's and are simple rectangles with shallow curved arches for the heads. The wood sash windows are double hung with one light per sash. Window sills are cut stone and the window heads are shallow brick arches. Three dormers appear in the attic, each with a grouping of three windows and roofs that are hipped and shingled. A double window occurs in the east gable end. The basement windows are small openings in the rough stone foundation and have stone sills and lintels. The main entrance is accented by a large massive stone arch in which a transom window is located. The entrance door is double with a half glass in each.

Most of the changes to the building's exterior have occurred at the inside of the "L" near the entrance. To the north of the entrance a circular tower is situated. Formerly three stories high with a conical roof, it is now terminated by a flat roof at the roof line of the main part of the building. The entry way on the other hand, according to old photos, was originally only one and a half stories in height, but it has been extended to the main roof line. Also, two window openings on the east side have been bricked up.

The building is a typical example of the rural Kansas school building prevalent at the turn of the century.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Burns Union School in extreme southeast Marion county was the first consolidated grade and high school in Kansas. Shortly after the turn of the century, several school boards in the Burns vicinity decided it had become necessary to consolidate their schools. The area's sparse population was causing tax problems, and thus inadequate facilities; so in April, 1904, four districts in Marion, Butler and Chase counties voted to consolidate. On June 8 an election was held to select a school board for the new Union School of Burns, District 156-65. At an election held July 8 voters approved bonds totaling \$8,000 for a new building and on September 10 another election determined the exact site for the school.

Classes began September 6, 1904, in the old Burns grade school and the former post office building. Students were transported from a 43 square mile area to Burns via three special-order "buses" made by an El Dorado wagon maker, F. J. Newacheck. This is reportedly the first use of school "buses" in Kansas. On December 2, 1904, bids were received for the new school and local contractors, J. J. Clayton and S. Bell, were awarded the building contract with their low bid of \$7,200. C. W. Squires of Emporia was the architect and F. L. Giddings, one of the school board directors, was to supervise the work.

Although most citizens agreed on the consolidation proposal, some were dissatisfied with the site chosen; therefore an injunction was secured December 21, 1904, to prevent further work on the building until all previous actions were proven legal. Rev. George W. Durham, who had worked for the school consolidation, went to the state legislature in Topeka and was able to get a bill passed which legalized all the work of the school board. The building was completed in time for the opening of school in the fall of 1905. The total cost of the structure with its furnishings was \$9,000. Dedication ceremonies December 16, 1905, featured Gov. E. W. Hoch as the guest speaker.

The Burns Union School served as the only district school house until 1921 when a new high school building was completed. The original building was still used for classes until a further unification of school districts in 1965 terminated its use. In 1965 the Burns Community Historical Society, Inc., was organized and received title to the old school for use as a museum and other educational purposes.

The school has significance to the development of the public education system in Kansas since it housed the first consolidated grade and high school in the state.
