DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The McConnell - McGuire building is a three-story stone building distinguished by its fine cast iron ornamentation. Pilasters of iron demarcate the facade's three bays. Each bay contains three pairs of double hung sash windows in the upper stories, with the third story windows possessing round iron arches with keystones. The central window in each bay has cast iron decoration in the form of a lion's head in the center and a classical bust on the others. The remaining tympanums are rusticated as are the spandrels, with the exception of the center bay's spandrels which imitate smooth stonework.

The building terminates with a galvanized iron cornice and a stone parapet. The cornice is broken by the pilaster caps with heads of wolves.

The left side's first story windows are semi-circular and several of them still retain their original stained glass. There is a side entry at the rear. The upper stories repeat the motifs of the facade only without the ornamented tympanums.

The facade's first story is highly altered with the original columns and mezzanine windows being covered. The upper story leaded glass transoms have been covered also. The original pediment on the parapet no longer exists, and a fire escape mars the left side. The interior has also undergone considerable alteration with the upper floors, which were originally store space, serving as apartments.
