STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: PHOTOS The Lamar Hotel was Meridian's most outstanding architecturally significant hotel. It functioned as a hotel until it was acquired by Lauderdale County in 1969 and is presently used as the courthouse annex. Outstanding Classical Revival features of this structure are its rusticated smooth-faced coursed ashlar base, arcaded on two facades (north and west) and lighting a two-story lobby, and its corbel-tabled granite cornice highlighted by a blue frieze. Sullivanesque elements are the building's division into specific zones--ground floor, intermediate floors, and attic-and in the window arrangement of the intermediate floors to create vertical emphasis. Constructed in 1927, the Lamar Hotel was Meridian's first skyscraper, although it was soon surpassed by the Threefoot Building (b. 1929-30).
