Two stories high, topped by an octagonal domed clock tower, this courthouse has an amphi-prostyle two story tetrastyle Corinthian portico, pedimented and centered between end pavilions. The pediment has an oculus. Side elevations feature center pedimented pavilions with Corinthian pilasters. The walls have banded rustication with smooth faced stone and a simple full entablature at roofline.

In the interior a cross plan has all four entrances remaining open. The interior wainscoating is Georgia marble which is 56" high on the first floor. At the rear of the building is a new jail of red brick, built in 1967.
