Painted white, the two story brick structure has a balcony over the segmentally arched entry portico facing Washington Street which originally was a rear entrance. On the second story the arched windows were altered to square ones, but the round hooded arches remain as a decorative motif. The eaves are bracketed.

In the courtroom the coved pressed metal ceiling was saved. Its pattern is that of a "cathedral quilt". The egg and dart cornice is also of pressed metal. Four bladed brass ceiling fans remain suspended from the ceilings; plaster has been repaired, painted and draperies added. The old paneled judge's bench remains. The balcony has been enclosed for storage/office space. Paneling has been added in downstairs offices.
