This structure was built in sections. The facade is symmetrical with a tetrastyle entrance portico. The capitals from the fluted columns have been partially removed. The porch juts forward from the main mass of the building and has a full entablature, pediment with foliate design, and a bracketed cornice. Square windows are on the first story of the facade and Palladian windows are featured on the second story. The clock tower rises in four stages. The first stage is square and originally had a balustrade with corner urns. That has been removed. The second stage is octagonal, the third features the clocks and the fourth a bronze onion dome that is ribbed and capped with a knob.

The interior has been altered, ceilings have been lowered, acoustical tile added. An unusual feature of the interior is a small chapel outside the courtroom. It has a cross cut into the door, a lectern with Bible, four pews and is used locally for weddings, prayer groups.
