DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Bimson Blacksmith Shop is a one-story, single detached structure with a flat roof. The building is rectangular in shape with the front and rear facade narrower than the sides It is constructed of native pink sandstone, with a red contrasting sandstone around the windows and doors at each corner in a quoin effect. The stone is cut, rock-faced ashlar, lai in random fashion. The top edge of the building is cordoned and a foot below it are two more stone cordones, one red and one pink. There is a door in each wall, three windows in the east wall, three windows in the west, and two windows in both the north and south walls. The windows are lugsill, rectangular, with red sandstone lintel. Windows are non-original, fixed-sash, with windowpanes. The main doorway is semi-circular arched with a complete surround of radiating red sandstone voussoirs, and a keystone at the top. Other doors are flat-topped with non-original wood.

The Berthoud Historical Society has replaced part of the roof which had caved in, and repaired with the original stone the rear portion of the wall which was broken when the roof fell. They also replaced windows and doors which had been taken out by previous owners. The Society did an excellent job of necessary repairs and in no way compromised the integrity of the building.

The Bimson Blacksmith Shop is situated right on Highway 287, which runs through Berthoud. The building to the west of it is a large modernized structure, Chandler Manufacturing Corporation. The frame building to the east is an original false-front harness shop now used as a maintenance shed.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Bimson Blacksmith Shop is significant for its architecture and history.

The Shop is made of native (Lyons) sandstone, which is unusual for Berthoud, although not for the region as a whole. The style is also atypical of the architecture of historic Berthoud. The building is unique and esthetically pleasing.

The Bimson Blacksmith Shop was the first blacksmith shop in Berthoud. The present townsite was settled in 1884. Alfred G. Bimson came there in 1889 and started the blacksmith shop in 1893. He designed and built the building himself out of stone which was quarried west of town. The shop remained open until 1943.

A.G. Bimson's association with Berthoud went beyond pioneering and blacksmithing. He served a term as mayor of the town, and was active in community affairs. He was also an artisan who crafted wrought-iron objects of every kind, which he gave to his friends and associates as gifts. Some of these things are still in the building, which itself reflects his artistic bent.

Besides being essential to the town for horseshoeing, tool-making, vehicle and implement repair, the Bimson Blacksmith Shop served an important function as unofficial social center, an informal gathering place for the men and children of the town, where they met their friends and exchanged news and gossip of the day.
