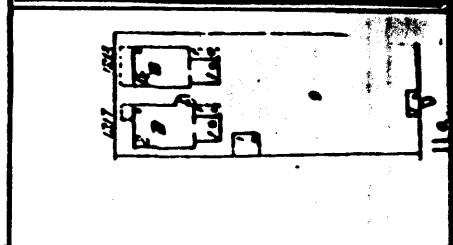

STATEMENT

This house illustrates the influence of the stick and shingle styles on a traditional Davenport house type. The basic 2-story, 3-bay front gable facade is enriched with a band of scalloped shingles between stories and the gable end is finished in vertical board and batten and intricately-cut apron. The small Eastlake porch is an effective finishing touch.
