"Brick Commercial": The Eckert House is an extremely well preserved example off commercial-settlement, vernacular architecture. Significant factors include: 1. Excellent state of preservation.

- Excellent state of preservation.
 Off square layout.
- 3. Metal "S" beam hardware on the north wall used to accomodate its unusual shape.
- 4. Metal numbers which date the structure(this is uncommon for Guttenberg.
- 5. Four bay(2nd floor) four bay(1st floor) commercial-residential face. Also of significance is the double entry way into the building including the entrance into the shop and the stairway entrance to the residential second floor.
 - 6. "Flying Buttress" eavespout.
