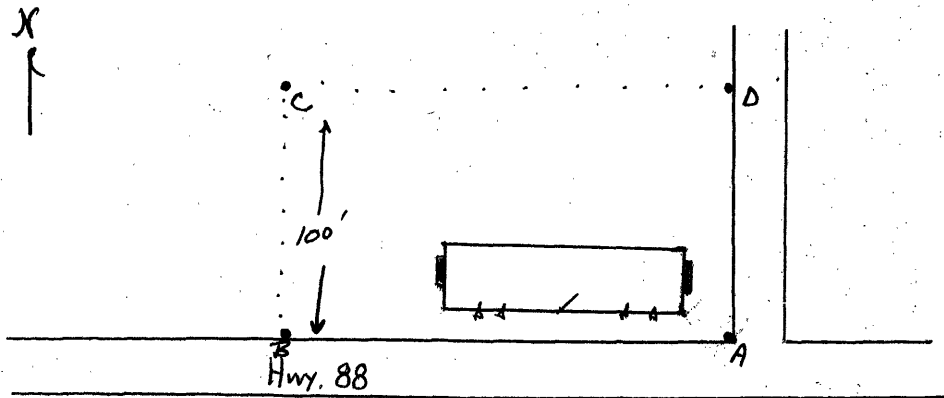
Verbal Boundary Description

Acreage @ .24 ACRES

Bounded on S by Hwy 88, on E by County Road, and on N and W by imaginary line established by trees to N approximately 30' to N and by imaginary line 30' to W of house.

Beginning at point A, the intersection of the New Salem road and Hwy 88; thence along the N edge of Hwy 88 120' to point B; thence N 100' to point C; thence E 120' to point D on the W edge of the New Salem road; thence S along said road to the beginning.
