

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage .33 ACRES

Beginning at point A, the intersection of a wire fence and a rock wall approximately 50' from the NE of the house; thence S approximately 120' along said rock wall to the intersection with another wire fence, point B; thence E along said wire fence approximately 110' to the intersection point C of an imaginary line 30' from the rear property line of said house; thence N along said line approximately 120' to the intersection with a wire fence at point D, said wire fence and to northern boundary of said site; thence W along said wire fence to the beginning.
