

| PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: <p><i>The original part of the structure is a kneewall one-and-a-half-story house constructed of three-and-a-half-inch plank. It measures approximately 34' x 21' and is five bays across by three bays deep. The sheathing is clapboard and the foundation granite block. The 2/2 sash windows have plain surrounds flanked by louvered blinds. The entry door is flanked by sidelights, above it are three panels topped by four rectangular lights.</i></p> <p><i>The side (east) wing is visible through the enclosed porch; sheathing is clapboard, there is an off-center entry topped by a shaped lintel. This portion of the structure had originally served as a kitchen/woodshed/open porch. In the 1950s or 1960s the porch was enclosed and a second story added. In the same year the gable dormers were introduced to the front of the main block, its rear dormers had been added some time earlier.</i></p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>(SEE CONTINUATION SHEET)</i></p> | |
| STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: <p><i>This building is constructed of three-inch vertical plank and dates from about 1835. Its planking survives. Mid-20th-century modifications to the wing have obscured its original appearance, but the main block continues to read largely as it has been since the time of construction.</i></p> | |

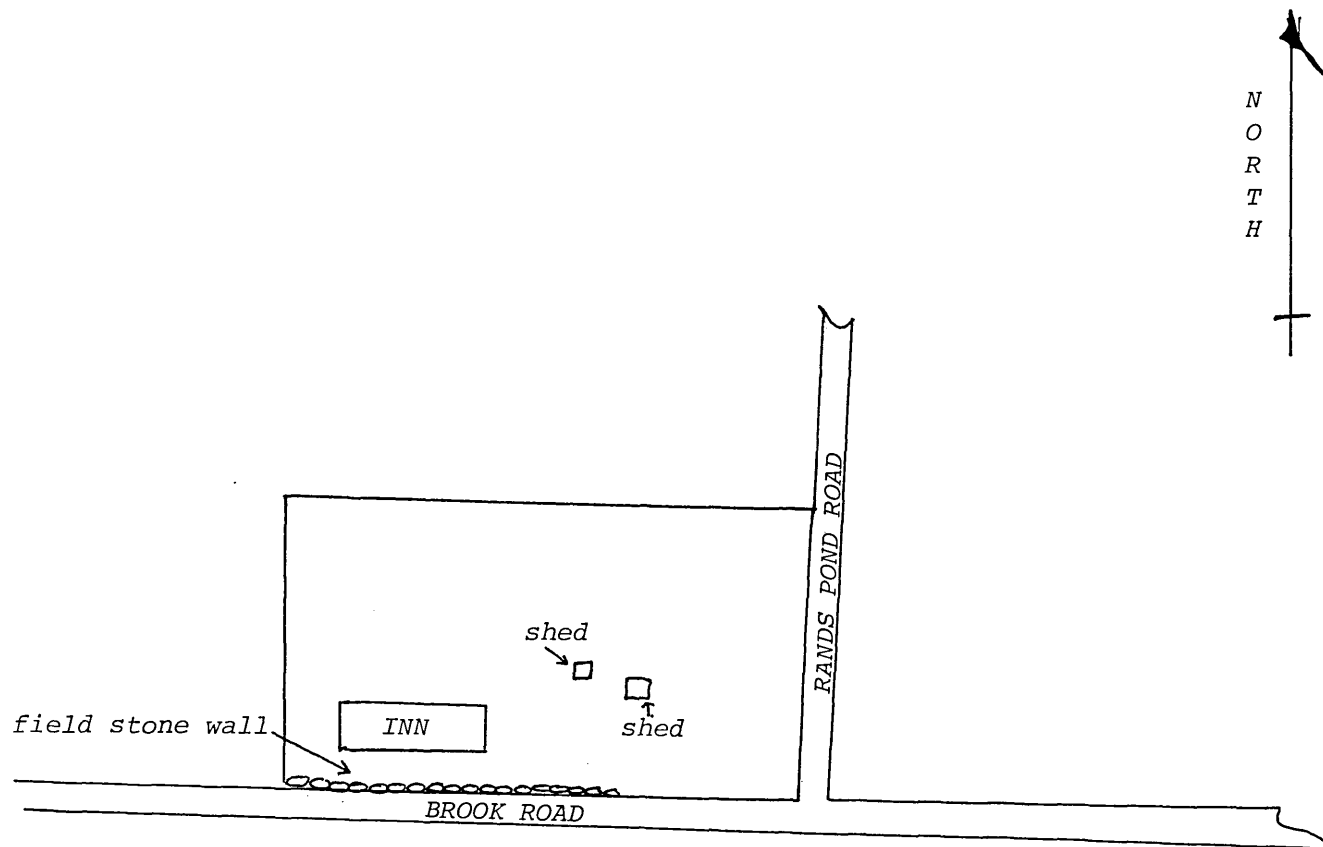
