PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION:			

The main block of the Purnell House is a one-and-a-half-story cape with gable roof, roughly 38' x 28' and five bays across by two bays deep. The exterior is clapboarded. The house rests on a field stone foundation and has front steps of granite block. The 6/6 sash windows have plain surrounds. The central doorway also has plain surrounds and is topped by a four-light transom window. A brick chimney punctuates the ridge on the south end of the building. The ell and connecting garage is roughly 27' x 22' and is three bays by two. Its windows are 2/2 with plain surrounds and the door also has plain surround. There is a modern diamond-pane bow window on the south side. The balance of the property is grassed with some trees.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

The Purnell House was constructed c. 1830 of three-inch vertical plank. It survives in good condition. In addition, this structure was once would by Daniel Emerson, toll collector for the Croydon Turnpike, the gate of which was located in the north meadow from 1830 to 1838, after which the toll system was discontinued. As toll collector, Emerson was a man of consequence in the community.


