7b. Briefly describe the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

This two story brick building has a bronze and granite storefront and an upper floor with cast stone trim. The storefront, which consists of three polygonnal display windows, two recessed shop entries, and a door to the second floor, is constructed of plate glass, bronze and polished granite. Above the shop is a bronze decorative cornice, partially obscured by a modern sign. Above the first floor the paned windows are enframed by stylized pilasters with cast stone trim. A parapet above the windows is constructed of brick with red diapering and cast stone coping.

SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)

This building is architecturally significant as one of a very few Moderne style commercial blocks in Maine. Moreover, the structure is in an excellent state of preservation and has undergone no serious alterations.

Constructed in about 1932, this building replaced an Italianate style structure identical to the two adjoining blocks. It was built by S. S. Kresge's for a department store with offices on the second floor. When it was completed it was one of the most modern and unusual architectural designs in Augusta.
