

Samuel Sanchez House, ill. 116, 100 yards W of
Highway 84 and 0.4 miles N of US 84 junction with NM 162.
Vic. Los Brazos.

4. Owner: Miguel R. and Cleofas C. Sanchez, Box 131,
Los Ojos, 87551

7. Description: rubble foundation; stucco over adobe; wood
shingle roof; brickwork chimneys; 1/1 double hung windows with
molding cornices; tongue and groove siding on dormers; frieze
boards; lathed porch posts and engaged columns with brackets.

8. Significance: Built in the 1880's, the house employs a
slightly modified officer's house plan (see Part I, pp. 16-17);
its many milled ornaments make it a fine local example of the
Folk Territorial Style.

10. Acreage: less than one. UTM Ref: 13 360880 4069870

Boundary: A rectangle, measuring approximately 100' by
120', formed by a line parallel to and ten feet from the house
walls. Since this property is unplatted, the boundary has been
drawn tightly to include only the historic structure.
