3.  $1\frac{1}{2}$ -story, 3-bay wood-framed building, with a pitched gable roof.

4. large T-shaped brick building, extensively altered. One pavilion (warehouse), 20 bays long, is 2 stories and has a flat roof and parapet. Perpendicular to this pavilion, and extending eastward from it, is a larger, 1-story pavilion (heavy forging and machine shop) with a steep, pitched gable and monitor roof. Both pavilions have steel truss roofs and steel concrete superstructures, corbeled cornices and brick piers along each elevation. Most original 12/12 wood sash windows have been covered up with cinder blocks. Smaller brick and cinder block pavilions project from the main pavilions.

The total complex has 49, 602 square feet of space (source: assessor).
