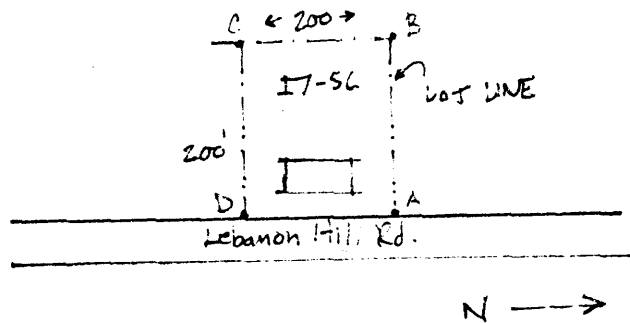

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage less than one acre

The boundaries correspond to those of town lot 17-56. Beginning at a point on the west side of the Lebanon Hill Road, proceeding west 200' to point B, thence south 200' to point C, thence 200' east to point D, thence 200' north to point A. The boundaries were selected to include the house and its immediated domestic space. The property includes one contributing and no noncontributing buildings.
