The nominated property consists of a rectangle, 23 feet wide by 31 feet long, whose vertices coincide with the outside corners of the bridge abutments at each end of the bridge, and includes only the bridge superstructure and substructure.

Because the bridge is located on a public road, there are no legal boundary lines for the ends of the bridge. Therefore, these boundaries are drawn to encompass only the superstructure and substructure of the bridge itself.

Bridge no. 30-257-400 is located 14 miles south and 9.7 miles east of Miller and carries a local road over Sand Creek. This 26-foot, singlespan, steel stringer bridge has I-beam pile abutments with concrete backing and wing walls. The concrete deck is poured on vaulted corrugated steel forms which sit between and on the lower flanges of the steel I-beam stringers. The floor system has nine stringers. Two angle sections, on angle section posts, form the railings along each side of the bridge. The creek bed under the bridge has been capped with concrete (deteriorated) reinforced with square steel rods, with some rods having longitudinal ribs and others having transverse ribs.

The bridge retains excellent integrity.

Bridge no. 30-257-400 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for iron and steel frame bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion A because it was one of the first bridges built by Hand County forces. Bridges, such as this one, built by county forces prior to the formation of the State Highway Commission in 1919, represent attempts by local governments to break the hold of private firms over bridge construction in their county. The bridge retains excellent integrity.

In January 1915, the Hand County Commissioners rejected all bids from private firms for the County's 1915 bridge projects. In May, the Commissioners decided to hire a construction foreman, buy bridge steel from the Minneapolis Steel and Machinery Company, and use county forces for labor for all bridge construction projects in 1915. In April 1916, the Commissioners again decided to build the county's bridges themselves and to buy the bridge steel from the Minneapolis Steel and Machinery Company. J.J. Woodward was hired as bridge foreman and 12 locations were selected for new bridges, including this site. Woodward was again hired as the County's bridge foreman in 1917, and by March of that year, construction of this bridge had been completed for a total cost of \$1931.
