Bridge No. 48-244-204 is located 0.5 miles west of White River and carries a local road over the Little White River. The bridge is composed of 18 concrete slabs, each measuring 16 feet in length. The slabs rest on seventeen concrete piers, four square concrete piles each, and two solid concrete abutments with wing walls. The deck is a concrete slab with an asphalt surface. The railing is a concrete balustrade with one panel per span.

The bridge retains excellent integrity.

8. Significance

Bridge no. 48-244-204 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for reinforced concrete highway bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C as the longest concrete slab bridge in total length in South Dakota. The bridge retains excellent integrity.

Bridge No. 48-244-204 was built by the South Dakota State Highway Commission in 1936 for a crossing (formerly SD Highway 44) of the Little White River. Sixteen surviving concrete slab bridges were inventoried in South Dakota. Among them, Bridge No. 48-244-204, measuring 314 feet, is by far the longest. Among the remaining bridges, the next greatest total length is 120 feet.
