 NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION

The # 8 Haldeman Voting House is situated on a large flat lot on the south side of KY Route 174 in the town of Haldeman.

The # 8 Haldeman Voting House is constructed of fieldstone and flush mortar. Exposed beams project from the replacement-shingle roof. One over one windows are placed on the east and west elevations with three 2' x 2' single lights located under the south gable eave. The windows have ashlar cut stone sills, but lack lintels. The three lights on the south elevation were positioned high to give light and to ensure privacy to citizens voting in three booths located under the windows. Victorian beaded boards seal the gable ends between the stone walls and roof. A capped yellow brick chimney is located at the center of the roof ridge.
