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NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION

The # 12 Cranston Voting House is situated on a large flat lot on the corner of Clear Fork Road and State Road #377.

The # 12 Cranston Voting House is constructed of ashlar stone with beaded mortar. Exposed beams project from the original standing seam metal roof. One over one windows are placed on the east and west elevations, with three 2' x 2' single lights located under the north gable eave. The windows have ashlar cut stone sills, but lack lintels. The three lights on the west elevation were positioned high to give light and to insure privacy to citizens voting in the three booths located under the windows. Victorian beaded boards seal the gable ends between the stone walls and roof. A capped yellow chimney is located at the center of the roof ridge.

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NARRATIVE STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The # 12 Cranston Voting House meets criterion A and is a significant physical representation of the New Deal. It was constructed by the WPA and used exclusively as a voting house during the period of significance. The # 12 Cranston Voting House has retained a majority of the original materials and is recognizable in function as a voting house. The # 12 Cranston Voting House is located in its original setting and location, and has retained its integrity of association as a building constructed by one of the New deal era agencies.
