While the supplier of the yellow colored structural clay tile of this barn is unknown, the owner/builder is known from the 1979 Mail Questionaire to have been Joe Seda. The use of structural clay tile for farm buildings, for round barns in particular, was an improvement developed at the lowa Agricultural Experiment Station in the early 20th century. In addition to the clay tile exterior wall, the central clay tile silo, which in this case preceeded the barn by two years, is another important characteristic of this type.
