Bridge no. 03-327-230 is located 5 miles south and 0.3 miles west of Cavour and carries a local road over Pearl Creek. The 54-foot, single-span, steel Queen-post pony truss bridge rests on concrete abutments with concrete wing walls. The superstructure has bolted connections at the panel intersections and is composed as follows: the upper chords consist of two channel sections riveted with a continuous steel cover plate along the upper flanges and with batten plates along the lower flanges; the lower chords and diagonal members consists of two angle sections riveted with batten plates; and the vertical members consist of two pairs of angle sections riveted with lacing bars. The plank deck is supported by steel I-beam stringers with channel section bridging. The stringers sit atop steel I-beam floor beams which are bolted to gusset plates suspended below the lower chords. Sway bracing is provided by paired angle section kneebraces which are riveted to the lower interior side of the vertical and to the top side of the floor beams. Bottom lateral bracing consists of angle section cross-braces. The railings along each side of the bridge are formed by three angle sections.

The bridge retains excellent integrity.

#### 8. Significance

Bridge no. 03-327-230 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for iron and steel bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C as a representative example of a riveted Queen-post bridge in South Dakota. Bridge no. 03-327-230 retains excellent integrity.

Only a few riveted Queen-post bridges survive in South Dakota. Of these structures, this bridge is the longest in span with a documented builder. It was built in 1913 by the Iowa Bridge Company of Des Moines, Iowa.
