Recent Successes

The Hamilton-Trenton-Bordentown Marsh

The northernmost tidal freshwater wetland on the Delaware River, located 2.5 miles from the NJ State Capitol building in Trenton, is known for its significant biodiversity and rich cultural history. This important open space resource, consisting of 1250 acres of wetlands and 1700 acres of adjacent uplands, much of it in state and county parkland, is an oasis of natural wildness in a densely populated urban area. A partnership of public and private landowners and citizen volunteers met for two years and in 2010 completed a "Cooperative Stewardship Plan" for the marsh, along with short and long-term action plans and a draft Cooperating Stewardship Agreement to formalize the partnership. Their goal is to protect the valuable resources of the Marsh, while enhancing public appreciation through education and recreation.
