1. Tennessee Riverpark's Chattanooga Riverwalk

Project Goal

Congressional Districts: TN - 3

Develop a 3.5-mile riverwalk extension trail that will connect downtown Chattanooga to the St. Elmo neighborhood. Through partnerships, work with the Lookout Mountain Conservancy to connect the future riverwalk trail to the trail systems on Lookout Mountain. The new trail will facilitate linkages to the Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park. Easements are now complete and construction of the initial section of the riverwalk extension from the Tennessee Aquarium to St. Elmo Street on Chattanooga's south side is ready to commence in early 2014. Meanwhile, planning continues on the final mile of trail to the base of Lookout Mountain.

NPS Role

Continue to support Hamilton County, the City of Chattanooga, and the Trust for Public Land by providing planning, technical assistance, and funding guidance for the design and implementation of this trail corridor.

Project Goal

Explore opportunities to redevelop brownfield sites in Chattanooga into parks and greenspace. Research the feasibility of establishing a greenway along Chattanooga Creek that could connect the community of Alton Park to the Tennessee Riverwalk.

Support park planning and working with existing community groups and businesses to enhance economic and recreational opportunities.
