DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

New Orleans' Garden District had its beginning with the subdivision of the Faubourg Livaudais in Jefferson Parish in 1832 and the incorporation of Lafayette City in 1833. Encouraged by rail transportation and the rich silt deposited by an 1812 crevasse, successful New Orleans merchants bought these suburban sites for their fine homes. As new business flourished on the Lafayette river front, the area farthest from the commercial activity along the docks had become the choicest residential area and had become known as the Garden District. In 1852, Lafayette was incorporated into the city of New Orleans as the Fourth District.

Principally a residential area, the Garden District contains in its nearly 80-block area a concentration of domestic architecture from the 1835-60 period including raised cottages, a great number of mansions having two-story galleries with superimposed Classic orders, several rows of modest shotgun houses and camel-back designs, a few early Creole cottages and a sprinkling of diverse styles including Gothic, Greek Revival, and Italianate. Ornamental cast iron is generously used, not so frequently for gallery supports as for railings and for the fences which surround the gardens which have always distinguished the district.

Gardens blend newer construction into the environment. Later 19thcentury houses include the ornately gabled "Swiss" Eustis-Koch House of 1876 and the Bradish Johnson House (now Louise S. McGehee School) of 1872. Major architects of New Orleans who are represented include Henry Howard, James Gallier, Jr., James Freret, William A. Freret, James H. Calrow, and Thomas K. Wharton. There is a scattering of good 20th-century houses.

There are a few 19th-century churches in the District. Shops along Magazine Street and St. Charles Avenue are generally newer and less sympathetic. A number of apartments have been constructed along St. Charles Avenue, which boasts one of the few active streetcar lines in America. An asset of the Garden District is Lafayette Cemetery No. 1, established in 1833. Handsomely maintained, it has good examples of the aboveground tomb architecture characteristic of the New Orleans area.

The Garden District was the home of Confederate Generals Leonidas Polk and John B. Hood and was also the area chosen by General Benjamin Butler for quartering Union officers. In 1889, Jefferson Davis died at the home of his friend, Judge Charles E. Fenner at 1134 First Street. Edgar Degas visited at 1331 Third Street, the home of his uncle, Postmaster Michel Musson. George Washington Cable, at his house at 1313 Eighth Street, a national historic landmark, entertained Mark Twain, Joel Chandler Harris, Lafcadio Hearn and Charles Dudley Warner on a single, singular evening.
