Located at the edge of Springer in Colfax County, New Mexico, the Mills House is situated on a slight rise near the Cimarron The three-story residence, which faces south, contains thirty-two rooms and hallways. It is constructed of adobe, painted white, and topped by a dark metal mansard roof. The house is built above a six-room basement, only five of which are accessible. A two-story wooden porch encloses three of its sides, and protective wooden wainscoting runs along the exterior of the first floor wall. Nearly all of the exterior wooden trim is painted green. Four chimneys protrude above the roof line. Many of the windows on the first and second stories are set in pairs and all have double panes of glass, as well as wooden shut-Dormer windows admit light and air to the third story. The front entrance consists of elegant double doors which open beneath a fixed rose glass transom, and give access to a front hallway with a lavish two-story staircase. The larger west wing of the house seems to have been the public or formal area, since its detailing is elegant and its rooms are larger than those in The west wing room on the second floor was originally large enough to have been used as a ballroom or reception room, but has now been partitioned into two smaller areas. wing of the house, which is generally simpler in detail, could well have been for the private use of the family itself.

Melvin W. Mills, the man for whom this house was built, and after whom it is named, was born in 1845 in Canada, educated at Law School in Michigan, and had arrived in the mining settlement of Elizabethtown, New Mexico in 1868, attracted by the widely circulated tales of its riches in gold. He engaged in mining and ranching as well as in the practice of law, gaining a reputation in this profession through his defense of several of the area's notorious murderers and desperados. In 1872, Mills was instrumental in the founding of Cimarron, which replaced Elizabethtown as the Colfax County seat after the mining boom col-In 1875 he was elected to the State Legislature, but was falsely accused of murder by a defeated opponent and nearly lynghed. He was saved only by the arrival of U.S. Cavalry. In 187/ he played an important role in the transfer of the county seat to Springer, made desirable because of Cimarron's decline when the Santa Fe Trail days ended and the railroad began operating in the state. Mills, at that time, was acting as county attorney. He assisted in the platting of Springer and moved there himself, building his extraordinary house. Mills was also associated for some years with Lucien B. Maxwell, owner of the famous Maxwell Land Grant. After Maxwell's death and with the decline of his land grant organization's fortunes, Mills became involved in disputes with recent settlers over the public vs. private status of the old grant. Although Mills lost his lavish home because of financial reverses, he was brought back to it to die, in accordance with his earlier wishes. Throughout his

ritory's leading and most colorful figures remains secure.

From the standpoint of architecture, the Mills House is probably unique in the nation. For, although it is in the French Academic style, it has a definite New Mexican air due to the work contributed by local craftsmen who were trained in the Greek Revival techniques that prevaled in New Mexico during the Territorial Period. The porch of the house is definitely Territorial in design, and the craftsmen also left their distinctive

residency in Colfax County his influence on the affairs of northern New Mexico was great, and his reputation as one of the Ter-

touch on the interior's lavishly carved walnut trim and paneling. Not only is this blending of styles unique, but the scale on which the styles were applied is fairly unusual. In the eastern United States, where buildings in the French Academic manner had been constructed since before the Civil War, they occurred commonly as town houses, smaller than the Mills House, and usually built as part of a block composed of several identical structures. The Mills House, with its thirty-two rooms and hallways, is considerably larger than a town house, and would have been an impressive residence anywhere in the country during the 1880's,and especially in New Mexico. That this French Academic building should have occurred at such a late date (for the school's influence was nearly played out then in the east) is understandable because of the time lag that generally controlled the development of trends in the southwest.


The architectural importance of this three-story residence lies partially in the mixture of French Academic and Greek Revival styles, and partially in the consistency of proportion and the blending of detail. The overall unity of the structure is remarkable, and testifies to the competence of its designer.

Materials used in construction include metal shingles for the mansard portion of the roof, and the cast iron railing that encloses it. Both the roofing and the railing were obviously imported from at least as far away as St. Louis, indicating the effort expended to achieve the desired result: an elegant and finely done house which has no equal in the southwest of its period.
